ORDINANCE # 9-2014

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX RATE FOR THE CITY OF MARION, TEXAS FOR THE TAX YEAR 2014; PROVIDING FOR THE 65 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER EXEMPTION; PROVIDING FOR THE PUBLICATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND PROVIDING FOR THE EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ORDERED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARION, TEXAS THAT:

We the City council of the City of Marion, Texas does hereby levy or adopt the tax rate of \$100.00 Valuation for this City for tax year 2014 as follows:

\$.004603 for the purposes of Maintenance and Operations

\$.0005 for the payment of Principal and Interest on debt of this City.

\$0.005103 Total Tax Rate

The 65 years of age or older exemption permitted for the 2014 ad valorem tax year shall be \$7,500.00.

There are no discounts allowed for early payment.

WHEREAS, it is deemed fair and reasonable to implement the State Law H.B. 30, Section 130, which allows a taxing unit to increase the penalty on delinquent accounts by an amount not to exceed 15% (fifteen percent) of the taxes, penalty, and interest, now therefore:

- a. Levying of Tax:
That all City property taxes that remain delinquent on July 1st of the year in which they become delinquent shall incur an additional 15% (fifteen percent) penalty to defray costs of collection since the City has contracted with an Attorney to collect delinquent taxes.
- b. Application:
A tax lien shall attach to all real property on the tax imposed to secure payment of the penalty.


This ordinance after its adoption by the City Council shall be published in the official newspaper of the City.
